I St Mall Project


- Goals:
 - Improve Pedestrian Safety
 - Reduce Rodent Population
- Strategies:
 - Lower planting beds to sidewalk level to improve sightlines
 - Install Xcluder anti rodent mesh
 - Additional lighting (pole and string)
 - New plantings
 - New seating/shade options
 - Big Belly trash/recycling


Community Corner
