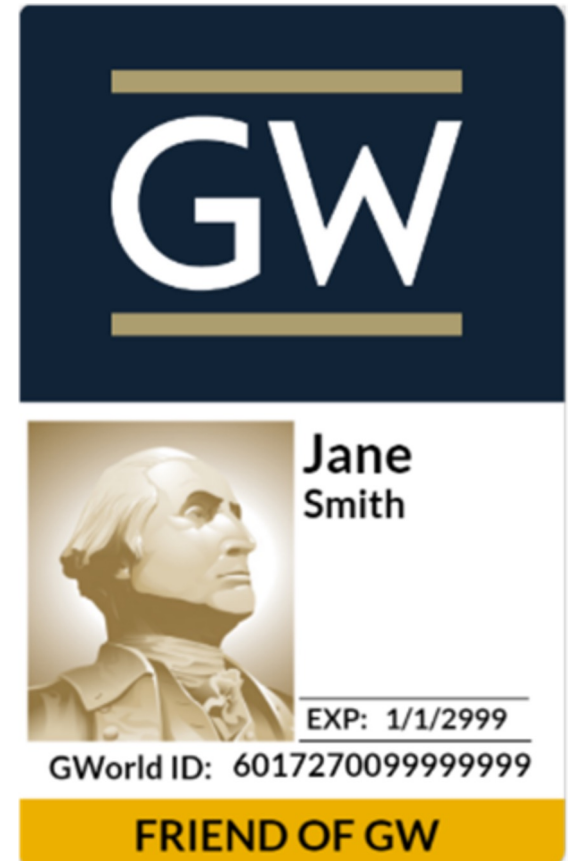
Friends of GW GWorld Card Program

Community members can apply in person at the GWorld Card Office (800 21st St NW, G05) with a valid **D.C.- issued Driver License or D.C.-Issued ID Card**.

Residents who do not have a D.C.- issued Driver's License or D.C.-Issued ID Card can submit **a utility (electric, gas, water, cable) bill, no more than 1 month old**, as proof of residency through our **online authorization portal**.

Once the application is received and reviewed, OGCR will notify applicants via email. Approved community members can then visit the GWorld office to pay, take their photo, and pick up their Friends of GW Card. Cards. **Community members must bring a state-issued ID for verification at the time of the card pick-up.**

- Law School (University Yard) Exterior Waterproofing – Work ongoing and continuing till early next month. Currently targeting August 13th.
- 22nd Street closure between H and I Street scheduled for August 3rd. This is needed so that a crane can be staged on 22nd Street to deliver roofing materials to the Science and Engineering Hall roof.
- Gelman Library HVAC Renovation - Set to re-open on August 12th.
