### Ongoing Activities:

- Repair work in the garage will begin next week starting on Monday. Work hours for this component of the project will be 7am - 7pm Monday through Saturday. We expect this work will take approximately 4 weeks to complete. As previously noted, the impact of this work will be noise and dust.
- GW employees and contractors will be in the building on a more regular basis over the next 6 weeks to inventory existing rooms and services as preparations are made for the renovation work.
- One of the building's elevators is out of service. One of the two elevators will remain out of service throughout the renovation project. Work on the out of service elevator will be ongoing during the project.
