Repurpose underutilized buildings and landscapes for programs that benefit from the campus' remote location and restorative setting.

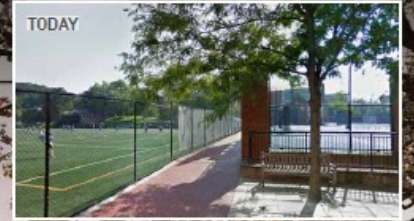
